

## Riegel Ridge Community Pool – 2023 Operating Information\*

### Limited June Opening Activities – open to Members and Non-Members

- Saturday, June 3 & Sunday, June 4: Open from 1pm to 6pm
- Saturday, June 10 and Sunday, June 11: Open from 12pm to 6pm

### Summer Schedule – open to Members and Non-Members

- **Saturday, June 17<sup>th</sup> to Sunday, August 27<sup>th</sup>:** Open Daily from 12pm to 7pm
- **Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>:** Open 12 pm to 7 pm (**NO LAP SWIM**)
- **Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>:** CLOSED
- **Saturday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> to Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup>:** Open 12pm to 6pm

### Dedicated Summer Camp Swim

**10am to 12pm** Monday through Friday the pool will be open for Summer Camp participants ONLY. Closed to the public.

### Dedicated Lap Swim – June 20 to July 27

We will offer **Lap Swim** from 8am – 10am **Tuesday and Thursday ONLY**. The pool will be open for LAP SWIM only and only the lap swimmers will be allowed entry to the pool. **The First day is Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. THE LAST DAY of dedicated lap swim will be Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup>.** A lap swim lane is always available during normal pool hours.

### Aqua Zumba/Aqua Fitness

**Beginning June 19, 2023, we will offer Aqua Zumba and Aqua Fitness as follows:**

**Aqua Zumba:** Mondays @ 6pm, Thursdays @ 12:30pm (no class July 3-7)

**Aqua Fitness:** Tuesdays @ 12:30pm, Wednesdays @ 6:15pm (no class July 3-7)

- **\$10 drop-in fee per class**
- **10 class prepaid card may be purchased for \$80.** *Must be used within 6 months of purchase at either the Fitness Center or the Pool*
- **Aqua Zumba and Aqua Fitness are included in a paid active membership to the Pool ONLY.**
- **Our last Aqua class will be held on Thursday, August 24.**

### Daily Rates for non-members and guests of members

- \$12 Adults/Teen (12 – 64 yrs.)
- \$10 Seniors (65 yrs. & older)
- \$10 Children (12 months – 12 yrs. of age)

- Children under 12 months are free, those 12 months and older are \$10 each

#### Guest Passes

- Family Membership: 6 people/passes per season
- Individual Membership: 2 people/passes per season
- Two-Person Membership: 4 people/passes per season
- Senior Membership: 2 people/passes per season
- Senior Couple Membership: 4 people/passes per season
- Young Adult Membership: NO GUEST PASSES.

#### Special Events!

- **Fun Friday – Family Float Night** from 4pm to 7pm. Bring your favorite float and paddle around the pool!
  - Friday July 7, July 14, July 21, July 28, August 4, August 11, August 18
- **Holland Township Community Appreciation Summer Pool Party** – Saturday, August 19 from 12pm to 7pm. **FREE** to all Holland Township Residents (**proof of residency required**). Children **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.

#### Equipment/Pool Toys & Flotation Aids:

- All persons must supply their own chairs, towels, and umbrellas. There will not be any chairs available for use outside of staff.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation aides will be allowed. No inflatable “swimmies” are allowed.
- Life Jackets are not to be worn on the slide.
- RRCP has a limited supply of flotation aides available for general use.
- Patrons are permitted to bring their own goggles, kickboards, pool noodles, dive sticks.
- The following items are **NOT ALLOWED** in/around the pool:
  - NO Rafts, Tubes or other types of floating lounge equipment
  - NO Balls of any kind – soft or otherwise. No ball playing in/around the pool.
  - NO Water Guns.

#### Inclement Weather/Emergency Closure

- During Pool Operating hours:
  - When Lightning or Thunder is observed, the Pool and Pool Deck will be cleared of all patrons for 30 minutes. An announcement will be made when the Pool closes and re-opens. For safety purposes, the swing set and any other metal playground equipment will be closed.
  - If additional Thunder and/or Lightning is observed during the original 30-minute closure, then the delay is extended an additional 30 minutes. For example, 15 minutes into the original clearing for weather, Thunder is heard again. This extends the closure another 30 minutes, for 45 minutes total.

- Rain Checks may be provided when the Pool has to be closed due to severely inclement weather or other contamination of the pool also known as an Emergency Closure. The only time a Rain Check will be granted is when these events result in closure of the pool prior to its normal closing time.
  - Pool Entry time up to 2 hours prior to Emergency closure: Rain Check Issued
  - Pool Entry time over 2 hours prior to Emergency Closure: No Rain Check Issued

<b>Rules of Conduct</b>
-------------------------

- NO swimming when Lifeguards are not present.
- Diving is permitted only in designated Diving areas.
- Appropriate swim attire is required in Pool area.
- Dressing and Undressing shall be done in locker-rooms only.
- Children using the multi-purpose pool must be attended by an Adult at all times.
- Young children MUST wear approved swim diapers.
- Changing of diapers on the pool deck or lawn is strictly prohibited.
- All persons having a communicable disease, open blisters or cuts, sore or inflamed eyes, ears, nose or mouth infection, excessive sunburn, or any type of skin disease will be excluded from the pool area.
- Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past 7 days.
- Animals are prohibited at the Riegel Ridge Pool unless they are Service Animals accompanying persons with disabilities.
- No glass containers, alcoholic beverages, smoking (vaping, chewing tobacco) or gum chewing allowed in the Pool area.
- Excessive horse-play will be grounds for expulsion from the pool.
- Parents are primarily responsible for the safety of their children and must be supervised by the parent at all times.
- The Riegel Ridge Pool Staff or Manager may close or limit the swimming facilities or establish such additional rules and regulations if deemed necessary for the protection or welfare of persons using the facility.

<b>Penalties</b>
------------------

- Any person who violates RRCP rules and regulations will be subject to immediate removal from the facility.
- Memberships are subject to revocation or suspension without refund.
- Memberships obtained by means of fraudulent statement may be revoked without refund.
- Anyone transferring a membership card or receiving a transferred card may have pool privileges revoked, for the remainder of the season, without refund.
- Destruction of property may result in suspension or revocation of membership or entry, without refund.
- Trespassing during or after hours is subject to revocation or denial of membership or entry, without refund.
- These same rules apply to those using the pool on a Daily Entrance fee basis.
