RIEGEL RIDGE COMMUNITY POOL – POOL RULES

- Membership cards must be presented for admittance
- No person will wear anything other than a bathing suit at the pool
- Disposable diapers are NOT permitted in the pool
- No Smoking or use of e-cigarettes or vaping devices of any kind on Riegel Ridge property
- No Food or Beverages in the POOL
- No Horseplay, rough or rowdy behavior or other conduct which affects the safety of others
- No diving except for in permitted areas
- No unnecessary splashing
- No running on concrete
- No balls, floats, or other toys in pool (except for float night)
- Only US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are permitted in the pool. Young children should be monitored closely. No SWIMMIES or inflatable flotation devices allowed. (Pool noodles are permitted)
- No alcoholic beverages (All coolers and bags are subject to search)
- Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering or asked to leave the premises immediately
- No glass, knives, weapons, drugs, personal grills, sternos, drones, water guns or water cannons. Water balloons can be used outside the pool
- Do not enter pool if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
- No animals, except service animals, are permitted on pool grounds. Please be prepared to show official documents of the service animal
- Pool staff has the final say on the opening and closing of the Pool due to inclement weather and/or electrical storm
- If your child is unable to swim by themselves, they must be supervised by an adult
- Must be able to swim in deep water to go down the slide. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Expectoration (spitting), roughness, rowdiness, running, profanity, or other conduct affecting the safety, welfare, and comfort of others shall not be permitted
- Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests. Guests shall be accompanied by a member at all times.
- Pool Managers may initiate temporary rules and/or instructions to ensure the immediate safety and security of swim pool users.
- Rough horseplay like lifting, dunking, chicken fighting and tossing other swimmers is not permitted for the safety of everyone.
- The lane is for lap swimmers only. Please stay out of the lap lane unless you are swimming at least one full length.

SLIDE RULES:

- Must be able to swim in deep water
- Obey all instructions given by the lifeguard
- One person on the slide at a time
- Wait at the bottom of the slide stairs until the person in front of you reaches the pool ladder.
- Go down the slide feet first only (seated or laying down).
- After exiting the slide, swim to the ladder and exit the pool via the ladder.
- No flotation devices on the slide, including life vests
- No stopping on the slide
- No more than one person at a time
- No head-first sliding allowed at any time
- No waiting in the pool at the bottom of the slide to catch your child. Slide users must be able to swim on their own.
