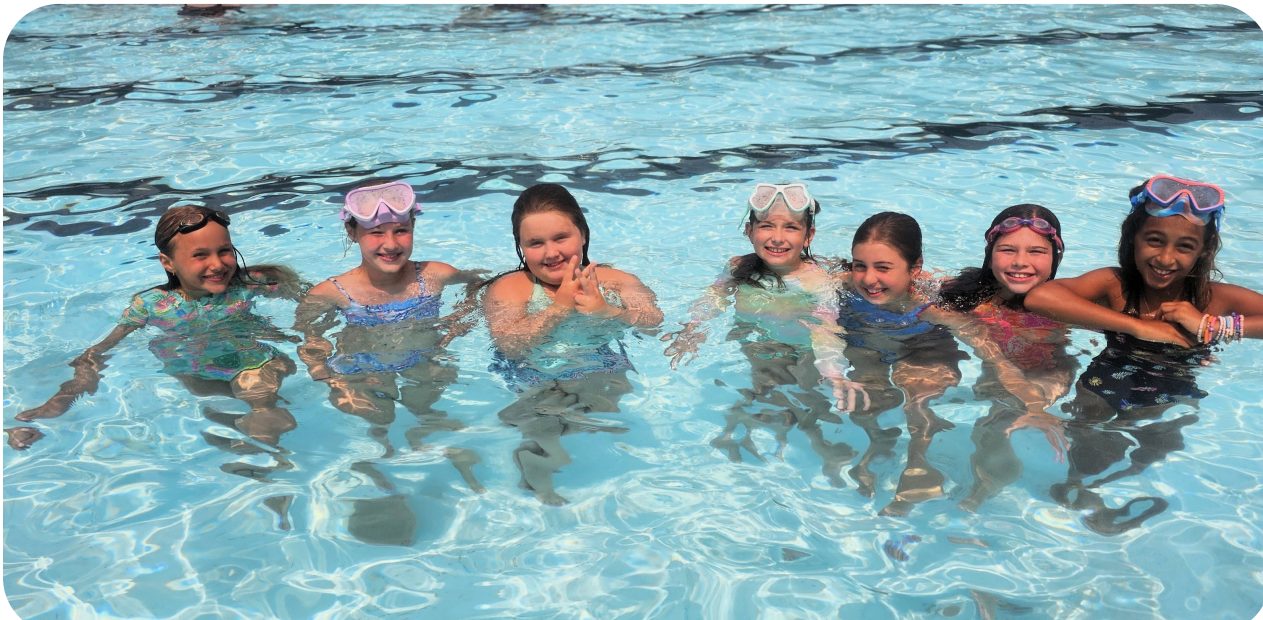

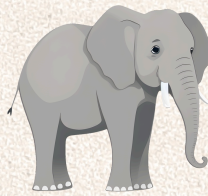


A Day in the Life of

SIBLING DISCOUNT \$15

For Example: If you have 3 campers signed up for the same amount of weeks: 1st camper pays full price, 2nd camper receives \$15 off & 3rd camper receives \$15 off. If you have a 4th camper they will also receive a \$15 discount.

A 3% service fee applies to all credit card transactions. To avoid this fee, payment may be made by debit card or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). Please note that an \$8 fee applies to declined credit card transactions, and a \$20 fee applies to declined EFT transactions.

REGISTRATION POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

PAYMENT POLICY

- Payment is expected, in full, at time of registration for Camp, Mini Camps and Field Trips.
- We accept cash, check (made out to Holland Township) or credit card (VISA, MasterCard and Discover). Your credit card will be stored on file if needed for future Summer Camp use. Please note that credit card payments incur a 3% processing fee. You can avoid this fee by paying with a debit card or directly from your bank account.
- \$15 sibling discount for additional campers signed up for the same amount weeks.
- Payment plans are available upon request. Email Director@riegelridgecc.org for details.

REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

- There are **NO REFUNDS**
- If a scheduled Mini Camp or Swim Lesson or Field Trip is cancelled by the Riegel Ridge Summer Camp, a refund will be issued.
- **If your camper chooses not to attend a Mini Camp or Swim Lesson or Field Trip for which he/she is registered, NO REFUND will be given.**
- Refunds may be granted for valid Medical reasons with a doctor's note, less a \$50 administration fee.
- A granted refund will be issued by Check and may take up to 4 weeks to receive.

TRANSFERRING CAMP POLICY

- Once registered, there will be a \$15 fee to switch weeks.
- Camp registration, including Mini Camps, **CAN NOT** be transferred to another camper.

AVOID BEING BLOCKED OUT BY

These policies and regulations are in place to ensure we have accurate attendance rosters at the start of a session and for the safety of your child to ensure that the American Camp Association ratios are followed.

- Camp registrations will not be accepted after 4:00 PM the Tuesday before the start of a week. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- Registration is limited. We strongly recommend signing up as early as possible.
